

Notice of Digital Services Act Compliance – No Digital ID Mandate

Context

On 28 August 2025, Hostinger issued an official Terms of Service update, effective 9 September 2025.

This scroll serves as lawful record and testimony that this update contains **no requirement** for Digital ID enrollment, biometric verification, or government-issued identity linkage.

Summary of Changes

Section 11 – Digital Services Act

Hostinger clarified its obligations under the EU Digital Services Act regarding illegal content and transparency reporting.

No new personal identity requirement was introduced.

Section 4 – Account Information & Security

Additional guidance for account safety and phishing prevention.

No change to login process or identity requirements.

Section 13 – AI Services

Clarified how Hostinger's AI tools process data.

No link to government identity or surveillance networks.

Declaration

Footer Clause – Baseline of Freedom

This record is preserved as a **baseline of freedom** for future comparison.

Any later imposition of Digital ID, biometric login, or state surveillance requirements on web hosting shall be recorded as a **material change of terms** and a violation of the living man's private estate and standing. This standing is not limited to Hostinger.
