Property Identification Code (PIC)

It has come to the attention of Biosecurity Tasmania that your property does not have a Property Identification Code (PIC). A Property Identification Code is a unique eight character code allocated by the Department of Natural Resources and Environment (NRE Tas).

On the 11th December 2024, **Biosecurity (Livestock Traceability) Regulations 2024** came into effect. It requires all persons who have livestock on their properties (including hobby farms) to have a PIC and to comply with livestock traceability requirements.

Biosecurity Tasmania is aware that you have livestock on the property **23 Alans Road, PETCHEYS BAY TAS 7109**. In order to comply with the requirements of the General Biosecurity Direction you will need to apply for a PIC. Currently, there is no cost associated with applying for a PIC.



If you have cattle, sheep, goats, or pigs on your property

- The property must have a Property Identification Code (PIC)

Refused for Cause 19/03/2026

Receiving cattle, sheep, goats, or pigs onto your property

- You should not import livestock that are not correctly identified (refer to Appendix 1 for correct identification)
- If livestock arrive without the correct identification, they should be correctly identified as soon as possible after their arrival
- The person transporting the livestock to you should provide you with an approved movement document pertaining to the livestock
- You need to keep the movement document for 7 years (cattle), 5 years (sheep and goats) or 3 years (pigs)
- You need to update the NLIS or PigPass database within 2 days of the livestock arriving at your property or before the livestock are moved off your property (whichever occurs first).
 - Note: if the livestock have been transported from a saleyard or were in the custody of a livestock agent during transit, the saleyard operator or livestock agent should make the NLIS or PigPass update for you.

Moving cattle, sheep, goats, or pigs from your property

- You should not supply livestock that are not correctly identified
- You should ensure all livestock are correctly identified before they are moved off your property
- You need to ensure an approved movement document pertaining to the livestock is given to the person transporting the livestock
- You need to keep a copy of the movement document for 7 years (cattle), 5 years (sheep and goats) or 3 years (pigs)

Approved movement documents

- An approved movement document is:
 - I. National Vendor Declaration (NVD), or
 - II. Tasmanian Vendor Declaration.
 - III. Post-Sale Summary (for movements from a saleyard to all properties).

I hereby undertake to abide by the conditions of use for these devices specified under the *Tasmanian Standards for the Identification of Sheep and the Biosecurity (Livestock Traceability) Regulations 2024*.
- (b) **Goats**

Privacy Statement

1. Purpose of Collection

The information being collected in this application is being collected for the purposes of assessing, in accordance with the *Biosecurity Act 2019*, the applicant's eligibility to attach and use a permanent identification device and for the maintenance of the department's livestock property database. The information may also be used to track the movement of livestock by inclusion on the National Livestock Identification System (NLIS) Database.

2. Disclosure of Personal Information

Personal information collected may be communicated to Meat and Livestock Australia and recorded in the NLIS Database. Personal information in the NLIS database including your name, business name and property name may be accessed by parties approved by Meat and Livestock Australia (MLA) to access the NLIS Database. Your personal information may also be provided to third parties where required by law and your basic personal information may be disclosed to another public sector body if it is necessary to do so for its efficient storage or use.

3. Result of Failure to Provide Personal information

If you do not provide any personal information requested in this application form your application to use a permanent identification device may not be processed.

4. Accessing Personal information

A person may request access to personal information collected by the Department of Natural Resources and Environment Tasmania and may be charged a fee for this service.
